

CIUPAGA (Polish Walking Stick)



Intricate scrollwork and engraving on handle.

In days of yore, the highlanders of the Carpathian Mountains carried *Ciupaga* (pronounced "chew-pa-ga") walking sticks. The legendary Janosik, a medieval Robin Hood-like hero of Tatra Mountain lore, was known for his. The handle functioned as an axe; the pointed tip doubled as a spear. The Ciupaga is crafted from a 34" long solid piece of mountain hardwood with a solid brass handle and fittings. Wt: 2 lbs.

Skill with this weapon requires the development of two separate weapon skills: Axe and Spear.

When used as an axe, this weapon will damage other weapons. When used as a spear it will not.
